
### Dear Fellowship Partners,

This year we are offering the series by Dr. Cloud, "Changes that Heal" for our Tuesday night group. It will consist of viewing a short video and facilitated discussion about it's content. Room series this past year, but things did not work out. Consequently, the ministry asked if I would come down and teach a series of workshops on leadership and ministry development. I will also be speaking in several churches and at the national conference on ministry to homosexuals. Please pray for me on my adventure to Quito from June 14<sup>th</sup> through

the 24<sup>th</sup>. Also pray for my family, as this will be the longest time I have been away from them. It is exciting to see how God will use this time to encourage and strengthen ministry within the Latin American countries.

This month we begin the process of saying farewell to our interns. Each will begin the task of pursuing the next step in serving the Lord. Since this is our first year, it's interesting to see how we have all been affected by the relationships we have formed. It is going to be really hard to let go of the friendships as we know them and allow each person to proceed. Please pray that each will go out with courage and conviction to impact their sphere of influence. We are only saying good-bye until the Lord causes our paths to cross again. Our role with them now changes to providing

## ministry update

Christians are suffering from a whole range of emotional problems: anxiety, loneliness, grief over broken relationships, resentment, and feelings of inadequacy. Often they have been struggling with those problems for years. They are people in **PAIN**.

Changes That Heal, the video series beginning in July, teaches that there are biblical solutions for your struggles with depression, anxiety, panic, addictions, guilt, and that these solutions lie in your understanding certain basic developmental tasks. These tasks involve growing up into the "likeness" of the one who created you.

Dr. Cloud, the presenter, says that because we live in a fallen world, we all have deficits. Transforming the effects of the fall and growing in the image of God is not an easy task. But God has promised that the "good work" he began in us, He will carry "on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus" (Phil. 1:6).
