Wouldn't it be wonderful if we could just "arrive" at maturity? We would only need to go to a seminar, read a book, enroll in a class, or attend a conference to suddenly have "the answer". And yet, God's Word says that His work in us will continue "until the day of Christ Jesus". Until then we will continue to be people in process and people who are incomplete.

In June, I had the privilege of attending the Pastoral Care conference offered by Leanne Payne. It was wonderful to have the opportunity to receive truth and experience God's healing presence in my own life as He continues His work of healing and restoration in my own soul. But, as I spoke with others attending the conference I recognized the human tendency to somehow come to a conference with the expectation that a work will be completed in us-and actually to look to a person, a book, a conference, a retreat, a seminar, etc as our "savior".

We don't like the uncertainty of being in process and of relying on the Lord's timing. We want a solution or an answer now. In fact, many of us turn inward and play the role of Holy Spirit in our own lives as we introspectively try to dissect the thoughts and intents of our own hearts. But this is a work reserved for the Spirit of God! We cannot fix

ourselves and we do not know what is best for ourselves. We must rely on the Spirit of the Lord and entrust the healing process to Him.

Although the Lord did meet me at my point of need and ministered to me through His Word and through others at the conference, experience has taught me that this is an ongoing process. Our sanctification will take place over time as we continue to entrust our souls to the One who is our Healer and obediently cooperate with Him as He faithfully exposes our sin and our need for Him.

On the last day of the conference, Leanne answered the question, Why doesn't healing 'stick'? Those who have had dramatic experiences during healing prayer sometimes wonder months later why they are again experiencing the same struggles as though no bondages had been broken. Her wise answer was to remind us of our personal responsibility to go on to construct the soul. We must faithfully respond to the small steps of obedience that the Holy Spirit speaks to us in order to continue to experience growth and freedom.

This obedience in each of our lives will look different. For some, here at Portland Fellowship, God has called them to attend our summer series in order to further the healing process in their life. For others, the Lord has spoken something different. The ministry here is committed to offering opportunities for growth and service as the Lord leads us.

One of those opportunities is the Sy Rogers Seminar coming September 6. If you have not heard Sy, you are in for a real treat. I believe he is one of the most dynamic speakers on sexuality.
