


Dear Fellowship Partner:

Participation in this initiative is simple. To start, go online to www.pfhope.com On the front page of this website you will find the items you and I will send to the church or churches of your choosing. This may be your church and/or a church God has impressed upon your heart to contact. We will send to the pastor(s) you have selected the book "Portraits of Freedom." This book will provide personal stories of sexually broken lives redeemed by Jesus. We will also send the pastor a copy of the Interactive CD ROM, The Map, containing a practical curriculum, video testimonies, and video Q&A to help a person begin to navigate through their journey to sexual and relational wholeness. Included in this package will be a \$5.00 Starbucks gift card. This gesture is intended to personally encourage the pastor to pause and reflect on information about Portland Fellowship and the items we have sent, and finally, we will include a handwritten letter from you. This is a very important part of the project. Your insight, experience and personal connection with Portland Fellowship will speak volumes to the leadership of the church. We will provide you with guidelines and sample letters to help you write a simple one-page letter.
