Dear Friends,

More than three and a half years ago, Jason Thompson and I (Denise Shick) first discussed the idea of making video lessons for families of loved ones who identify as transgender. Early in those discussions, it was as if some of the dreams and goals were on their way to being accomplished. But then life happened, and before we knew it, years had passed. Both of

us had many responsibilities and ministry work that kept us from accomplishing the goal we first discussed. But God had the perfect timing for us—we simply were not aware of that timing.

Scripture pronounces God's omniscience: He knows everything; He knows what will happen before it happens; He has foreknowledge. But, beyond God's foreknowledge, the Bible also refers to God's sovereign control of events—He makes things happen. The Bible also records God using prophets to announce future events. However, He does not always share what He is up to, or how events will be accomplished.

In short phone calls and brief meetings at the Restored Hope Network conference, Jason and I continued talking about our mutual goal, but could never find the right time to begin. Finally, last fall, God called to our hearts that it was time to rehash our plan and move forward. Jeremiah 29:11 says God has "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." Oh, how good our God is! No matter what you are going through, God has good planned for you, just as He had with the videos He prompted us to record.

God is more than capable of redeeming the bleakest-appearing circumstances. That is what He has done through this new resource. Many lives have been and will be redeemed as God formed His team to develop this resource, which is meant to bring comfort and love to folks going through heart-wrenching journeys with their gender-confused loved ones.

God knew ahead of time who the team members would be for this very important project. As we sought out, prayed, and talked with each member of the team, we saw evidence of God working behind the scenes. Each team member believed deeply in this project, and in the fruit that would come from the hard work ahead for each of us. Then, there it was. We saw a vision, three years in the making, come to life.

This past July, the team members met near Lexington, Kentucky, to start the filming process. As Tiffany was filmed first, the rest of us sat nearby, in awe of a mother's heart for her wayward child. Despite her pain, she has faith that God is walking this journey with her! The following video recordings were equally touching. As we watched these recordings, many of us thought of the ancient patriarch Joseph, who forgave and embraced those he cared for so deeply—those who had hurt him. Several of our guests understand the loss that families endure, as their loss is similar.
