hand (known mainly as 'Amy's husband'), only knew what was made public.

One evening, I said to my wife something to the effect, "I wish the church leaders would let us know what they're planning for the coming year." With confusion and maybe a hint of frustration, her reply was, "What do you mean? They talk about it all the time."

After discussing our individual viewpoints, we came to the conclusion that while the pastors frequently discussed church plans among themselves and with their staff, they struggled to convey those ideas to the entire church body.

Now, twenty-five years later and being in that position of leadership myself, I pause to consider how the church community or even those close to us understand the mission of Portland Fellowship. Even Cody, my now fifteen-year-old son, recently questioned, "Dad, what do you even do?" My inner voice was just like my wife's response, "What do you mean? I talk about it all the time."

I realize not everyone will know the work others do, nor should they. I honestly couldn't tell you what most of my closest friends do in their careers (especially if they hold IT positions), but this did get me thinking about the importance of providing additional opportunities to share what the Lord is doing in the lives of His people through this powerful, transformational ministry.

In addition, Portland Fellowship, being a highly controversial ministry, comes with various assumptions, accusations, and misunderstandings. Although the world would never embrace or approve of our ministry, it pains me to think that those in the family of God might also hold those same misunderstood viewpoints - possibly without even realizing it.


